Amen.



Church?

"I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD." Psalm 122:1

But let us be ever mindful that the Church is all of us who have one purpose – to be disciples of Jesus, fulfilling the mission He has given us and passing on the faith to future generations.



Great Lakes Scrips fundraising is Here, and you need to benefit from it. www.glscrip.com

Great Lakes Scrips (Scrips) is a gift card based fundraising program. When you purchase a gift card through Scrips you pay the face value of your gift card but Scrips charges HPC a discounted price. For example, If you purchase a \$100.00 gift card to a gas station, you pay \$100.00 and receive a \$100.00

worth of gasoline. Scrips however only charges HPC \$92.00 and HPC earns \$8.00 off that one lowing Sunday. purchase. Discounts range between 2% and 16%.

FUNDRAISER UPDATE

Our budget for the year includes \$3000 profit from fundraisers. As of the end of May, we have received fundraising income from the following sources:

Total \$2059.96

The cookbooks and 150th merchandise are either gone or almost gone. We do have a craft auction scheduled for October. The three fundraisers that do not require lots of work and time are Spartan Store (please turn in your VG's receipts, or just the points portion of the receipt - the collection spot is on the wall in the kitchen), GoodSearch/GoodShop (which pays us once a year in the fall), and the Great Lakes Scrip program.
