

What God has been doing through Operation Transit:

We keep hearing about how God has been answering your prayers and working through Operation Transit over the long term:

When a North African Christian recently shared the Gospel with a college student in her country, the student accepted Jesus as her Lord and Savior. She told the evangelist how she had gotten a good impression of Jesus while she was growing up: whenever she used to visit her grandmother's house, her grandmother would put on a video about Jesus, which she listened to while she played. It was a JESUS Film video that her grandmother had been given at one of our ports.

Last month I also heard this story of how a North African Christian came to know Jesus a few years ago: While he was waiting to board the ferry from Tangier to Spain, he started talking with the man waiting next to him. The other traveler asked him if he was a Christian. Once they were at sea the other man told him all about Jesus. As they pulled into the dock in Algeciras, the man prayed with him, asking God to give him a sign to let him know that the Gospel is true. The North African man went out and through customs first. When they saw each other again outside, he raised up an Operation Transit packet he had just gotten and said: "God already gave me the sign you prayed for."

The special training for this new job was intense, but I really enjoyed it!

Speaking of expanding ongoing responsibilities, Deedee has also been taking on a variety of new tasks for our ministry. She is most excited about helping encourage an atmosphere of prayer for our port's summer participants. Whenever I travel, of course, she also has to do even more at home, like getting the kids back and forth to their school (a nice half-hour walk from our house: photos right).
