After accepting a packet, women women told a young man to return it. The evangelist explained that Jesus is coming again, but came the first time so we could be forgiven. Relieved the man kept the packet.

A North African man accepted Christ with a North African evangelist. They stayed in touch by phone and internet, and by September the man asked to meet with other believers.

A North African believer eagerly took materials to give to others.

A North African man said, "Thank you. I was waiting for this!" Another man, already reading Matthew, listened to the gospel and when shown 1 Corinthians 15:3-6 with 500 witnesses to Christ's resurrection, he said, "Now I know the Bible is true!"

A North African doubted God's existence, but after hearing an evangelist's testimony, he accepted a New Testament.

An enthused man accepted a packet and ran to get his friend, who hesitantly accepted. Both immediately began to read.

A lady beamed as she took the packet. Another lady was full of gratitude yelling to her husband, "It's the New Testament!"

A man knew the Bible, even quoting verses. Excited to meet a Christian, he gave his contact information for follow-up purposes.

A man left his car and wife, jumped a barrier, and asked for a packet. With a packet in hand he elatedly returned to his waiting wife.

Two children immediately began to read the Wonder Books. In another car, children convinced the mother to accept.

A North African man showed a distributor a well-read Bible he had received several years before.

An older man joyfully accepted the DVD understanding it was the same as the video he had received years ago in his Berber language.

A lady recognized the packet and indicated she was a believer, evidently from having previously received a packet.

A teen-age son, upon seeing the packet, told his mother, "This is what we have been looking for."

Christian Lebanese students reaching out to a community of North Africans in a Spanish enclave of North Africa saw a young lady come to Christ. She told others including two young men. One, hurting because his girl friend aborted their baby, was touched that God willingly gave His Son and also accepted Jesus. The other took time to reflect. Then at a second meeting he indicated that he had received Christ. Two of these three new believers joined the Lebanese while they witnessed along the waterfront in the evenings.

Five Christian North African students did outreach in a predominantly North African city of Europe. They saw people come to Christ, like a 45-year-old man who repeatedly met for follow-up and today meets with a local pastor. They also helped train North African believers they met through the outreach to witness with others in the power of the Holy Spirit. One of these, an ethnically French man who had come to Christ through the witness of a North African and who was married to a North African, witnessed at least once a day for the coming week.

A North African believer refused the packet until the evangelist suggested he give it to a friend.

Some Spanish participants overcame fears of witnessing with North Africans.

A number of North African women continue doing follow-up in Arabic through various internet apps.

Europeans taking materials on a ferry to North Africa saw a North African accept a packet on the port, start to read the New Testament, and then keep it at eye level as he boarded the same bus they were taking to the boat.
