

in my exegesis class that week. In these verses lies the great commandment from Jesus, "Listen! Israel, the Lord our God is one Lord. Second is this; you will love your neighbor as yourself. No other commandment is greater than these" (Mark 12:29b-31, "Cassie Todd Translation").
