The Pastors' Corner: "Come Join Us"

Before God had a name God was seen and heard in a "burning bush." God was not the flame or the bush. But through the flame, Moses heard God and responded to God's call.

How can we recognize when God reaches into our world today? Like Moses, we must listen. Clearly there is a secular trend in America today but it may not be as dramatic as it first appears. In the magazine *Presbyterians Today*, a survey was made of "nones" – people who express no religious preference. (none)

... "Nones" rose from 3% in 1957 to 17% today.

...There are more "nones" in this country than mainline Protestants. (22% of whom are young adults.)

Perhaps there is an opportunity in this trend. "Nones" may share a lack of affiliation but they are different when it comes to religion. 36% of the "nones" indicate that religion is important in their lives. (*Presbyterians Today*, March 2010)

There is an opportunity for the church in this "wilderness" time. Many people are seeking hope and a foundation for life. We Christians believe we have an answer ... and that is to gather together as a community which reaches out to one another in love.

To gather these seekers we must not be afraid to ask them to join our community of hope. It is as simple as asking someone to "come and join us." It is as difficult as having the courage to open

The Day of Pentecost: The Birthday of the Church

Pentecost is the day we celebrate the birth of the church. It is a day of great celebration and thanksgiving. Before there was Christmas and Easter, there was Pentecost – at least as far as the liturgical calendar is concerned. While Easter celebrations may have happened in the years immediately following the first Easter, Christmas and Easter were not designated as official Christian holidays until the fourth century. Evidence suggests that churches observed Pentecost as early as the first century.

Pentecost initiated a more formal sense of community among the first believers who gathered to worship together. When Christians minimize Pentecost's importance in the life of the church, they discount not only the birth of the church, but also the community that Pentecost built. The season of Pentecost is the time to build the church.

THE DAY OF PENTECOST IS MAY 23RD – we will have a celebration and everyone can be a part! If you have something red to wear, please do! If you like birthday cake, please come! If you want to share with someone, bring a friend!
