- Acts 1:9

Fred and I will be hosting a prayer and study group in our home during the summer on Thursday evenings at 6:30 p.m. This is something you can participate in every week or at different times through the summer.

In the coming months, I plan on leading us into the next phase of building up the church that we began during our first congregational retreat last fall. We want our church to grow both spiritually and physically. There are two very important things we can be doing to accomplish that growth - prayer and visioning - so we can develop goals with an intentional process.
