I have spent the month of April and the beginning of May taking an online course, “Prophetic Preaching”, from Columbia Theological Seminary. I spent my first of two continuing education weeks for 2022 concentrating on the work that is required for this course. The students in the course are mostly highly experienced preachers, and the primary focus is on the work of preaching difficult issues and the issues that really should matter to the Church- issues that align with the call Jesus gives in

Matthew 25. How can we, the Church, keep at the center of our mission a primary focus upon caring for “the least of these”, and how can the job from the pulpit help a congregation consider what this means, and how, with greater passion, we can do so? An emphasis in the course has been upon congregational conversation about issues of systemic injustices and how they relate to scripture and our lives as disciples as critical to the work the preacher does from the pulpit. I am looking forward to helping make space for these conversations and communal discernment about listening closely to scripture, particularly in regard to caring for humanity and creation on the margins. This has been an excellent opportunity for me to consider, alongside of other pastors, life in the pulpit, and the many ways- fresh ways- that this work can be approached.

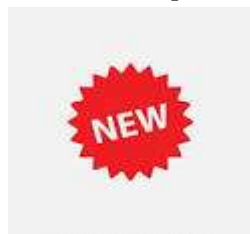

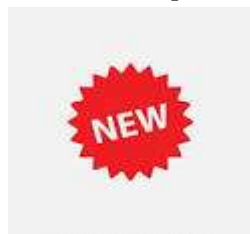
