Sunday November 2nd is All Saints Sunday. We will remember those who have gone before us. Please join us.



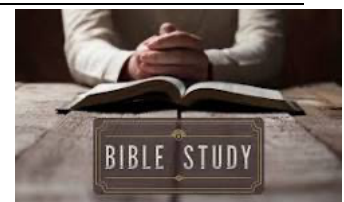
Time Change
