Our colleagues reported that the Lord is raising up more local Christians to participate in our two distribution stategies: Operation Transit is developing more leaders from Spanish churches; and more Arabic-speaking Christians in Germany are helping with our Gulf Partnership Outreach.

Our team's church-equipping work has seen many people come to Jesus, both through online outreach and in person through an Arabic-speaking church in Malaga. They saw a new Arabic-speaking church start up in another Spanish city. They are also excited to be able to to bring along some of the Christians they are mentoring, to do short term ministry in North Africa.
