Friends we are to have the mind of Christ in us. Paul reminds us of what this means in passing on maybe the earliest Christian Creed in existence in Philippians 2:6-11. Let us share in this affirmation of our faith together...

Though Jesus existed in the form of God, He did not regard equality with God as something to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, assuming human likeness. And being found in appearance as a human, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death— even death on a cross.
